# Service Recognition

#### **Background:**

The Victorian Eastern Region of the Australian Alpaca Association 10 Year Service Award was officially created in 2008 in recognition of service to the Region for a period of 10 years or more, as a member of the General Committee.

Brian Worcester was the first official recipient in 2008, however Bill Plunket was recognised for his service to the region in 2002.

#### Policy:

The service recognition should be used as an opportunity by the regional committee to demonstrate their appreciation of volunteers.

#### **Eligibility:**

Volunteering for the VER on a continuous basis as follows:

- Serving as a committee member
- Serving as a convenor of regional shows/events
- Volunteering and supporting in a variety of other regional activities

### History of VER Recognition Awards.

- 1. The Service Award was created in 2008 in recognition of service to the Region for a period of 10 years or more, as a member of the General Committee.
- 2. The inaugural recipient, Brian Worcester, was presented with his award (a plaque) at the Annual Dinner held at Amstel Golf Club, Cranbourne on 24th May 2008.
